A. Bleak Picture: a valley of scattered, dry bones.

- *Dry...very dry*

Why?

- *Dead*            *As a nation; spiritual life*  
*What meant the most to them?*

**“Can these bones live?”**

B. Restoration of the physical.

*“Prophesy to the bones!”*

Israel – a nation, a land

C. Restoration of the spirit.

*“Prophesy to the breath.”*

*The Spirit is life.*

- John 7:37  
*“If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink.”*

*The great privilege: the Spirit within.*

- Galatians 5:7-9  
5:22-23, 17  
*Spirit or flesh?*  
*How do you live?*

- John 7:37-53  
What does it mean to be thirsty?  
Come to me and drink.  
Why did the Pharisees not drink of the Spirit?
- Romans 8:  
The flesh vs. the Spirit.  
If, by the Spirit, you are putting to death the deeds of the flesh you will live.
- Jeremiah 2:1-19  
The prophets went after things which did not profit.  
Cisterns for themselves; cisterns that hold no water.
- Revelation 3:20  
Neither hot nor cold.  
In need of nothing?  
Rev. 2:6 What does it mean to have their lampstand removed unless they repent?
